Dr Brendon May is an experienced Interventional Radiologist; an expert in the art of image-guided minimally invasive procedures. After obtaining specialist training in diagnostic radiology at the Gold Coast University Hospital, Dr May completed his fellowship training in Interventional Radiology at the reputable Foothills Hospital in Calgary, a centre of excellence in trauma, oncology and organ transplants.

Dr May is one of only several doctors in Australia with the training to perform Balloon Pulmonary Angioplasty in patients with Chronic Thromboembolic Pulmonary Hypertension. Patients travel from as far afield as Western Australia to be treated by Dr May at The Prince Charles Hospital. In the private system Dr May is currently focused on Genicular Artery Embolisation, a cutting-edge endovascular treatment for osteoarthritis that is no longer responding to conservative treatment and for residual inflammatory pain following a total knee replacement.

Areas of Expertise

- Endovascular embolisation in trauma and vascular injury
- Pulmonary interventions, such as bronchial artery embolisation, pulmonary artery angioplasty, pulmonary AVM embolisation & treatment of acute pulmonary emboli
- Genicular Artery Embolisation for osteoarthritis & post-arthroplasty pain
- Interventional oncology, including TACE, SIRT & tumour ablation
